

EWI & Rendering Framework, Carmarthenshire.



TAD Builders Ltd have to date carried out the installation of external wall insulation (EWI) to over 600 properties in Carmarthenshire for Carmarthenshire County Council.

Our experienced site team of supervisors, carpenters, plumbers, electricians and plasterers readied the properties by removing external obstructions from the external walls including, soil pipes, down pipes, canopies, external lighting, satellite dishes and attached fence panels to prepare for the installation process.



Our team installed a Permaroc insulated over render system with 60mm phenolic insulation and dash render finish. All reveals were insulated and there was particular emphasis on correct detailing to the plinths to ensure no cold bridging and maximum efficiency to all properties.

To complete the project, we fitted aluminium cappingsills, GRP front door canopies new rainwater gutters and downpipes, soil and waste pipes. We also had to reroute/extend gas pipes and refit satellite dishes and external lighting.

All work was carried out with minimal disruption to the tenants who remained in occupation during the refurbishment works.



Following completion of the work on the tenant's property, we send out questionnaires to tenants asking for their feedback on works undertaken within their homes. This provides a 'full-circle' review and valuable feedback on the quality of service we have provided.
